

Event Alcohol-Beverage Registration & Permit

All alcohol-beverage exhibitors must **register** and obtain a **Special Event Permit** from the NSLC (contact info below) if they are going to sample and/or sell.

The permit must be displayed in the booth.

All products sampled at the show must be listed and sold at the NSLC. Exhibitors whose products are not listed/sold at NSLC are not permitted to sample or sell.

Any exhibitor from **outside** of Nova Scotia, **cannot sell** alcohol at the show, but **can sample** as long as their products are sold/listed at the NSLC (after registering and obtaining a permit from the NSLC).

ONLY Exhibitors and manufacturers **from** Nova Scotia, such as local wineries, micro-breweries and distilleries, can sell alcohol (after registering and obtaining a permit from the NSLC).

If you registered with the NSLC for last year's expo, please contact them **before March 31, 2017** to renew your permit in time for Expo 2017.

Please Note:

Products poured for the trade must adhere to the following maximums and tasting glasses provided for show patrons must be clearly marked to aid pouring and inspection. Maximum servings are based on alcohol content (by volume) of the product.

23% or greater - maximum serving 30ml

7% to 23% - maximum serving 60ml

Less than 7% - maximum serving 115ml
